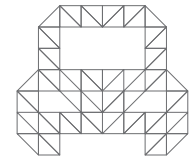
REACH YOUR MARKET

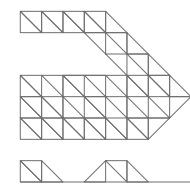

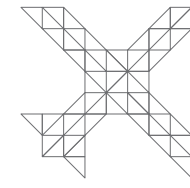


SEGRO Logistics Park Northampton's new strategic rail freight interchange provides national freight services via the West Coast Main Line with direct access to major UK and European destinations.

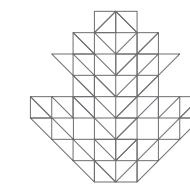

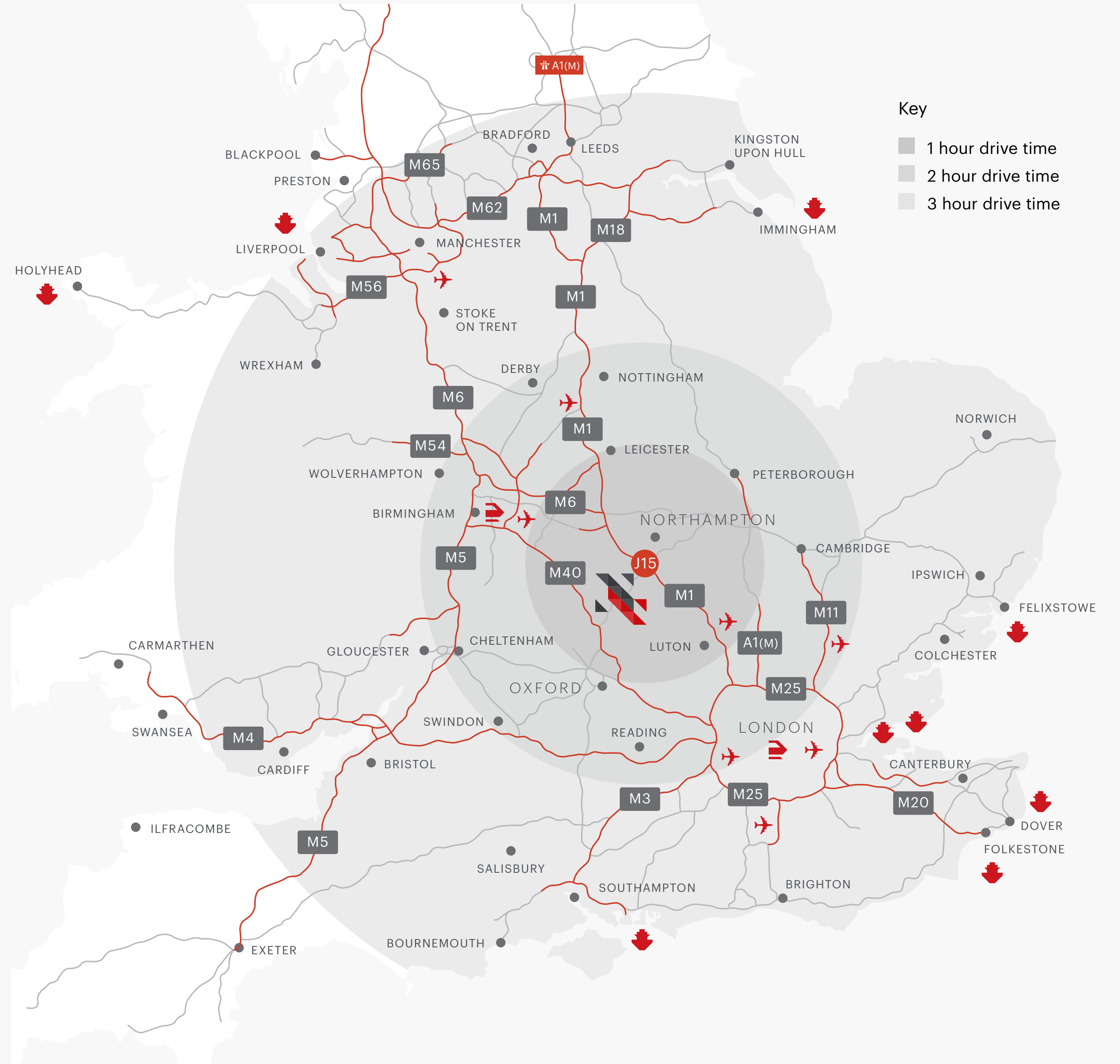

The 775m long, open access, strategic rail freight interchange is capable of receiving the largest container freight trains with storage capacity for almost 2,500 TEU (20 ft equivalent containers) and parking for over 125 trucks.

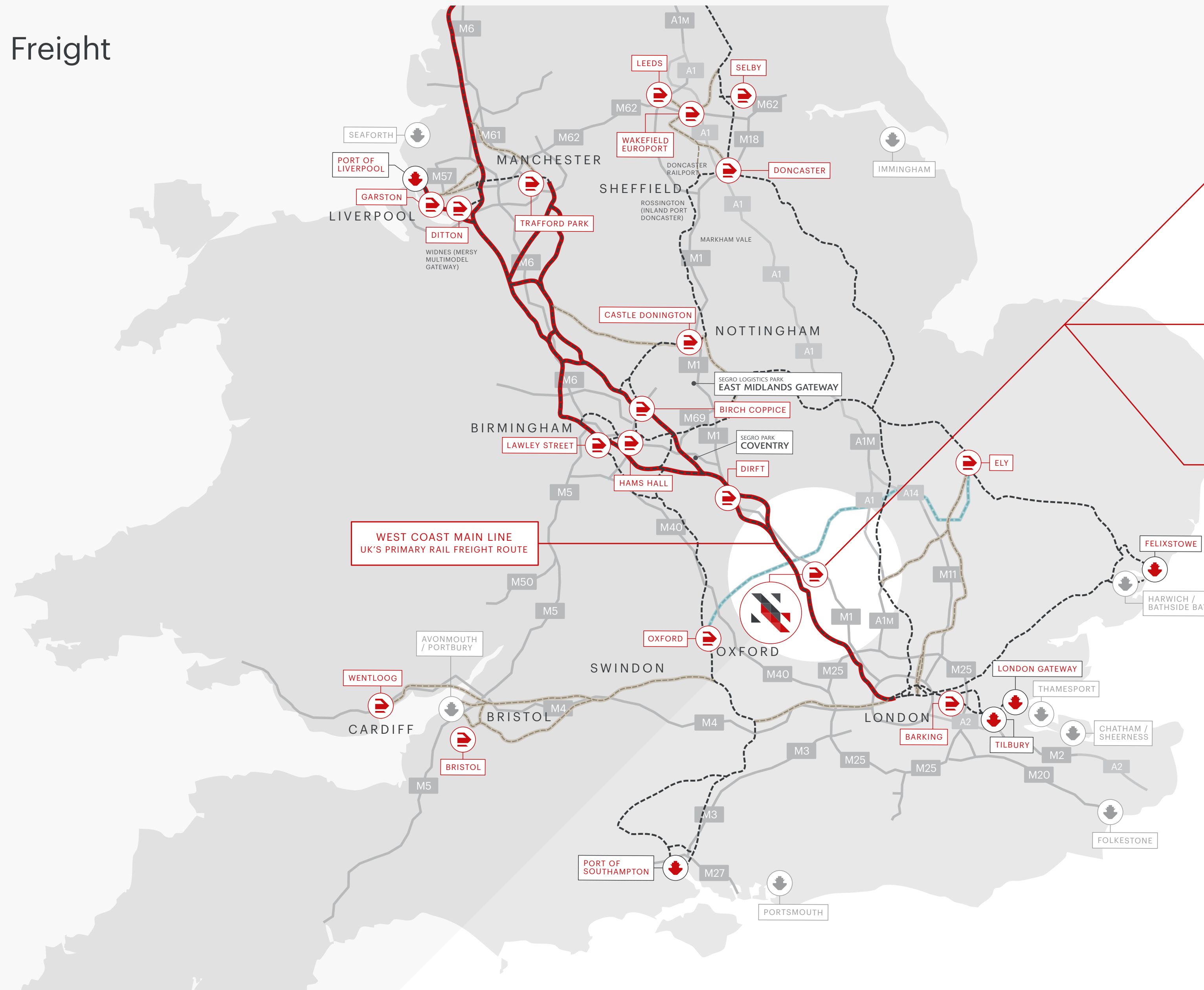
Maritime House - Rail Freight Terminal - SEGRO Logistics Park Northampton

TALENT ON DEMAND

Partnering with local councils and community groups, **SEGRO is rolling out an employment and skills programme** to train and connect local people with new opportunities.

SEGRO Logistics Park Northampton is set to create around 7,500 direct jobs, including 120 during the infrastructure construction phase, creating a huge impact on the local economy.

Labour

The population of Northampton has risen by 14% in the last 12 years, compared to a national increase of 6%, and the resident labour force is currently 148,400.

75% of the Northamptonshire workforce are already working in the services sector and within this 31% are in the area of wholesale distribution, ensuring that the local labour pool is ideally suited to working within a distribution environment.

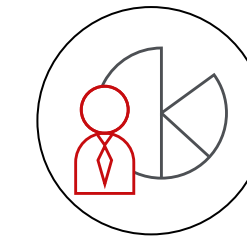
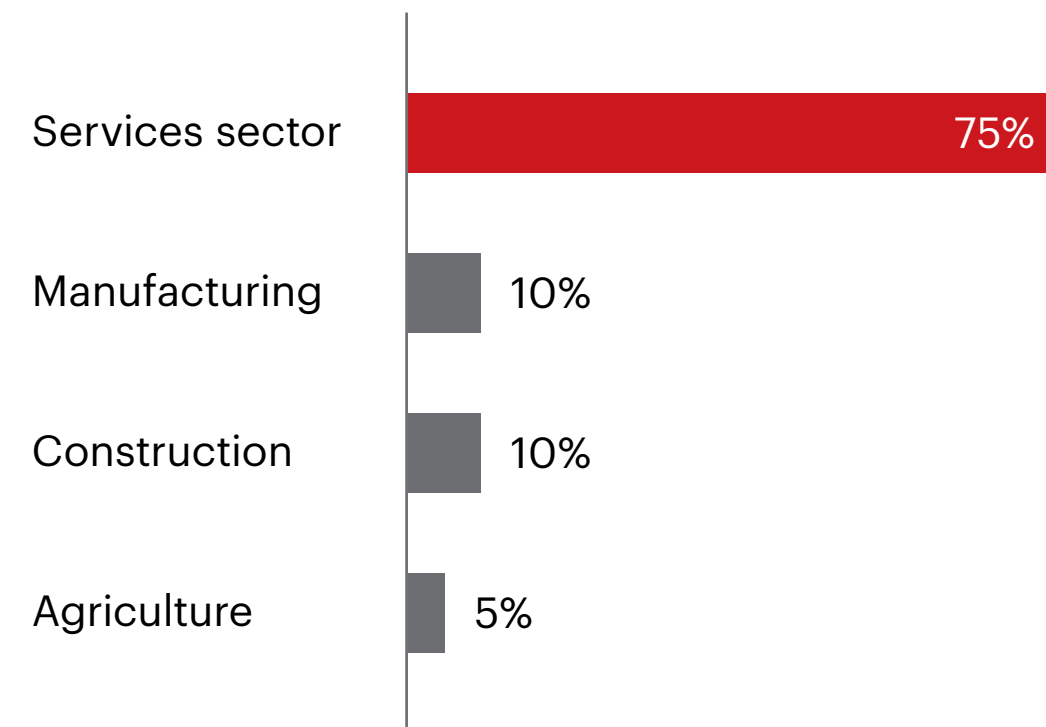
A sustainable bus route will connect SEGRO Logistics Park Northampton to the town centre and local neighbourhoods to the south.

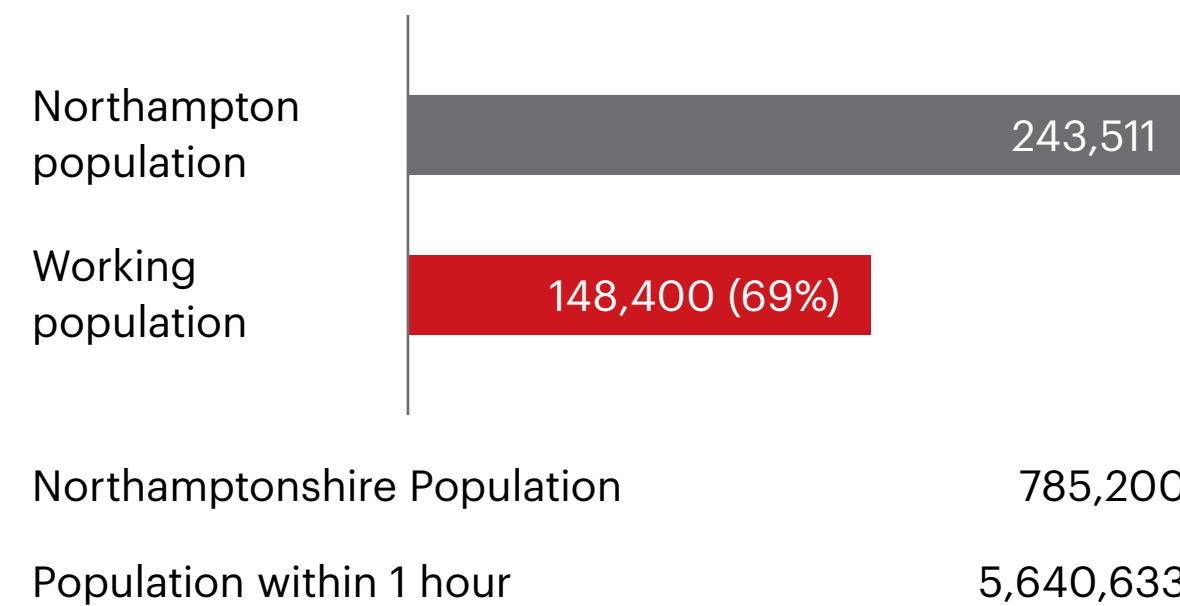

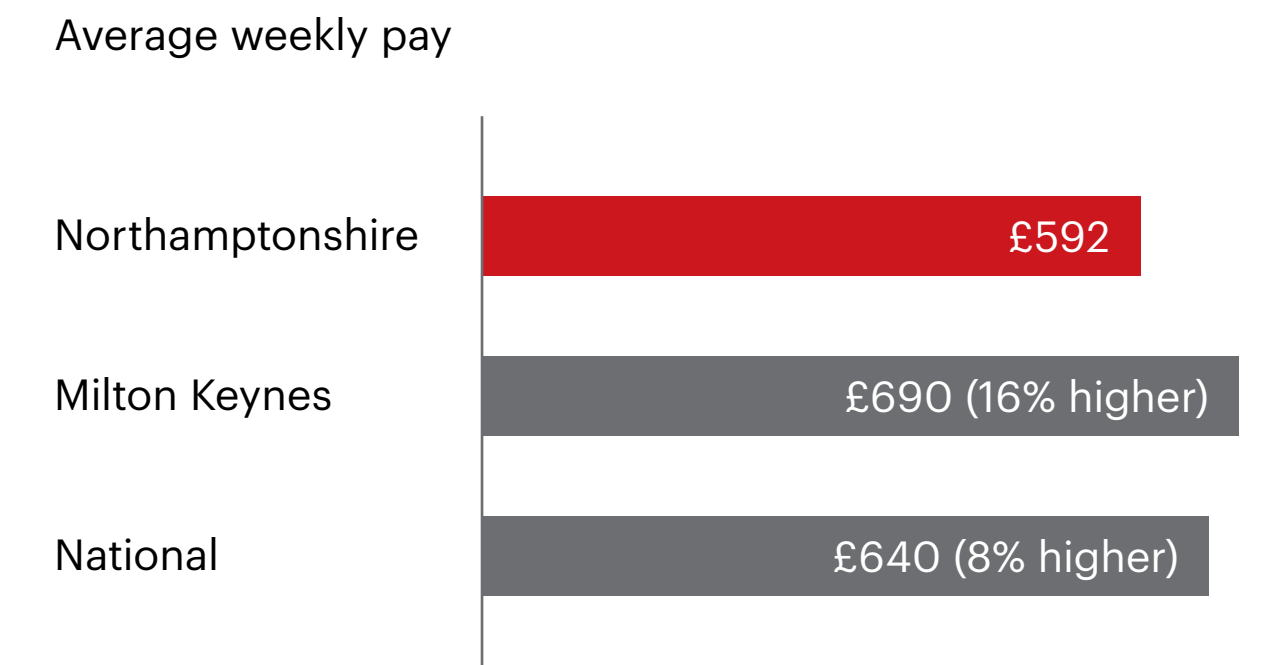
Workforce sector breakdown

Welcoming both employees and local wildlife alike, **SEGRO Logistics Park Northampton** has over 80 acres of parkland and amenity grassland, with 18km of footpaths, 20km of hedgerows, and 60,000 new trees.
